



On behalf of the American Board of Forensic Toxicology, I am advising you that the accreditation of Ascertain Forensics has been extended to November 30, 2021. The scope of the laboratory's accreditation is postmortem and human performance toxicology.

As it seems likely that North America will still be affected by COVID-19 through at least the first half of 2021, ABFT is working on a contingency plan that will allow for an online review of many of the records that would normally take place onsite. It is anticipated that the "virtual inspection" would occur around the same time as the regular onsite inspection (most likely third quarter 2021). 
